Attendees will be able to pick up these items at a **Prize Pick-up Drive Through** on **Saturday, April 17<sup>th</sup>** at the **Northwest Florida State College**.

Please arrive on time for your shift so your task can be explained to you. Attire for event volunteers should be casual but appropriate with comfortable shoes. No shorts or military uniforms. Please wear a mask when working with other volunteers and speaking to attendees in their vehicles. The Healthy Start Coalition will provide gloves, hand sanitizer, and masks. We would also recommend sunscreen, a hat, or sunglasses as this is an outdoor event.
